

Stockholm Waterfront To Become One Of The World'S Leading Meeting Venues

Stockholm Waterfront has been launched with great expectations - a congress centre with facilities for up to 3,000 people and a four-star hotel with 418 rooms right in the very heart of Stockholm.

Located between the World Trade Center and Stockholm's historic City Hall, right next to the Central station and the airport train Arlanda Express, Stockholm Waterfront Congress Centre is already being referred to as one of the world's leading meeting venues. The landmark Stockholm Waterfront is scheduled to open 2010.
