

## The Mills House Charleston Hotel Hosts Cast, Crew of Army Wives

'Army Wives' enjoyed the largest series premier in the history of the Lifetime Network and began its second season on June 8, 2008.

The show currently airs Sunday nights at 10 p.m. et/pt on the Lifetime Network.
