

ABA Development Breaks Ground on First of Three Hyatt Hotels This Year

ABA Development announced today the groundbreaking on its much anticipated six-story, 151-room Hyatt Place in Roseville, CA. Developed and owned by ABA Development, Roseville's Hyatt Place is ABA's first of three hotels expected to break ground in 2008.

The site is situated near the crossroads of Interstate 80 and Highway 65, with direct visibility from Highway 65.

RYS Architects (San Francisco, CA) is the architect of record. In addition to 1,500 sq. ft. of meeting space, an outdoor pool and a state of the art fitness center, guests will enjoy high quality amenities. The hotel will feature spacious, upscale rooms with 42" flat-panel HDTVs, Hyatt signature beds, oversized sofa-sleepers in each room, Starbucks(R) specialty coffees, and café quality foods. 'Bringing this high-end, lifestyle hotel to customers at a moderate price fulfills a vision we have been working on for quite some time,' Said Jesse Allison, COO and Co-Founder of ABA Development.
