

WestJet moves to Terminal 1 at LAS

WestJet today announced that it will be moving its operations at McCarran International Airport in Las Vegas (LAS) from Terminal 2 to Terminal 1, effective today.

Terminal 1 offers more amenities, such as additional shopping and restaurant choices for WestJet guests.
