The complete, top-to-bottom renovation of all guestrooms and suites includes outfitting them with signature Hyatt Grand Beds, state-of-the-art 42-inch LG flat screen televisions, modern furniture and fixtures, iHome clock radios, multi-media A/V connection access ports and fully updated bathrooms. The lobby will be reconfigured to offer guest check-in kiosks and a unique reflecting water-fire feature. The hotel will also be unveiling a new contemporary restaurant concept and a dramatic lobby level wine bar that will welcome local as well as hotel guests.

The hotel offers more than 30,000 square feet of newly renovated meeting space, which can be configured to accommodate both large and small meetings and events. Wireless high-speed Internet access throughout the building meets the technology requirements of today's business travelers. A brand new StayFit@Hyatt gym and a large (approximately 4,700 sq. ft) Regency Club, including an outdoor patio, will be added to the hotel.
